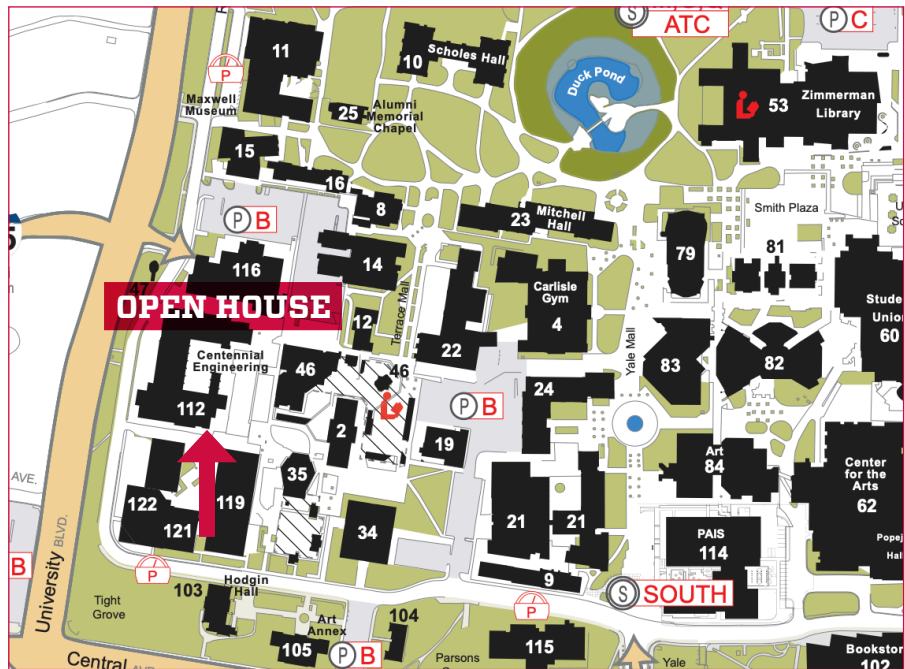
## How to find us
